Training fees are for 11 months unless a team advances to Regionals or Nationals.

Players on teams advancing to Regionals or Nationals are required to pay an additional month.

Seasonal registration fee is reduced to \$65 for each additional player for families that have already registered two players for a given season.

Seasonal registration fee is reduced to \$25 per player for children of board members and coaches

Monthly training fee is waived for U-18 & U-19 competitive players that are away at college

Tournament Player Only Registration Fee is \$25 per competitive season

Standards Regarding Mileage & Per Diem

If a coach has 2 or more teams at a tournament then an additional coach can be requested. Cost of all coaches are split between two or more teams.

All payments, including mileage, are only made if the coach incurs the cost. To the extent possible, mileage and per diems should be paid prior to the tournament, adjustments for costs not incurred can be made at a later time. For out of metro tournaments, the coach can elect to travel back home. Teams are responsible for the lesser of the cost of an overnight stay or the additional mileage.

Examples: If a coach rides with another coach, only one coach is paid mileage reimbursement. If a tournament provides complimentary lunch, then no lunch per diem is paid. Coaches are responsible for claiming the appropriate amount of per diem, based upon how they traveled and their attendance at team games.
