- Discussed problems with competitive teams not getting indoor soccer training times due to so many academy teams utilizing the indoor soccer complex.
- Parent/DOC meeting dates have been sent to Parris for publication. The next meeting will take place Dec. 13th 6 pm at the MAC.
- We will be using new uniforms next year--Nike since they will have a useful life of 4 years. The cost difference between the current uniforms and the new uniforms is \$1.
- Couple of coaching changes due to moves.
- There will not be a Nike or Barcelona camp this year.
- There will be a USSAO camp this year. It will probably take place in July.
- Things are going pretty well. Not any complaints in the last 6 weeks. Jimmy indicates that the coaching staff has a lot to do with this.

- ESC had a very good showing in the Norman Cup and a tournament in Texas.
- Coaches have been requested to complete their player evaluations by Jan. 30th for all players under U15.
- Starting to try to combine some A and B training sessions. It is sometimes difficult with scheduling.
